

# Columbia Middle School

## Dress Code Policy 2023-2024

*Columbia Middle School has a mandatory dress code policy. All students are expected to be in dress code every day. The dress code will ensure student safety, avoid unnecessary distractions to the educational program, and build school spirit.*

### Shirts

- Students Must be in an appropriate shirt.
- Shirts must have sleeves, cannot have inappropriate language or advertise for products that the buyer must be 21 or over.
- Shirts cannot say slang words that identify as products that buyers have to be over 21 (For example "Cookies")
- Shirts can be Long or short sleeves
- Logos and Brand Names must be appropriate

### Pants, Shorts, Skirts, Belts, Shoes

- Pants must be worn to cover hips and backside
- Must fit properly – not too loose or tight .
- Pants must be free of holes or tears and may not show skin
- Must be appropriate length – longer than fingertips
- Legging type material is inappropriate
- No open-toed or high heels allowed on campus
- Crocs must be worn with the strap on in the back, those without a strap are not allowed

### Socks, Leggings, Undergarments/Shirts

- Leggings may not be worn as pants
- Sweatshirts, Sweaters, and Coats must not have inappropriate language or advertise for products that the buyer must be over 21
- Undergarments must be covered at all times
- Logos and Brand must be appropriate

### Hats, Beanies

#### Dress Code Accessories

- Earrings shall be no longer than one inch from the ear (large hoops will be removed)
- Gauge or spike style earrings shall stay home
- Bare midriff or bare back blouses are not allowed to be worn at school
- Clothing or accessories that are deemed offensive to others or cause a disruption are not allowed
- Dying any part of hair in bright/vivid colors – including hair extensions is considered inappropriate if it becomes a distraction to the learning

environment.

- Cosmetics are inappropriate at school and if seen will be confiscated
- Items that are gang, violent, sex or drug related are inappropriate
- Bandanas, "do-rags," nylon stocking caps, or caps worn backwards are inappropriate
- Offensive Tattoos, permanent or temporary, are inappropriate and must be covered while at school
- Students tattooing themselves with pens or markers will be asked to wash it off their skin
- Facial piercings will need to be covered while on campus or should be removed

### Non-Compliance with Dress Code

- If an item that is not listed in this document causes a distraction to the learning environment, it will not be allowed.
- If you have a question about a particular item of clothing, it should be asked of the administration.
- BEFORE the item is worn, bring the item to school first and ask the administration if it is allowed to be worn
- Items only worn outside or at the gym, and are not to be worn inside classrooms
- Writing or logos must be appropriate

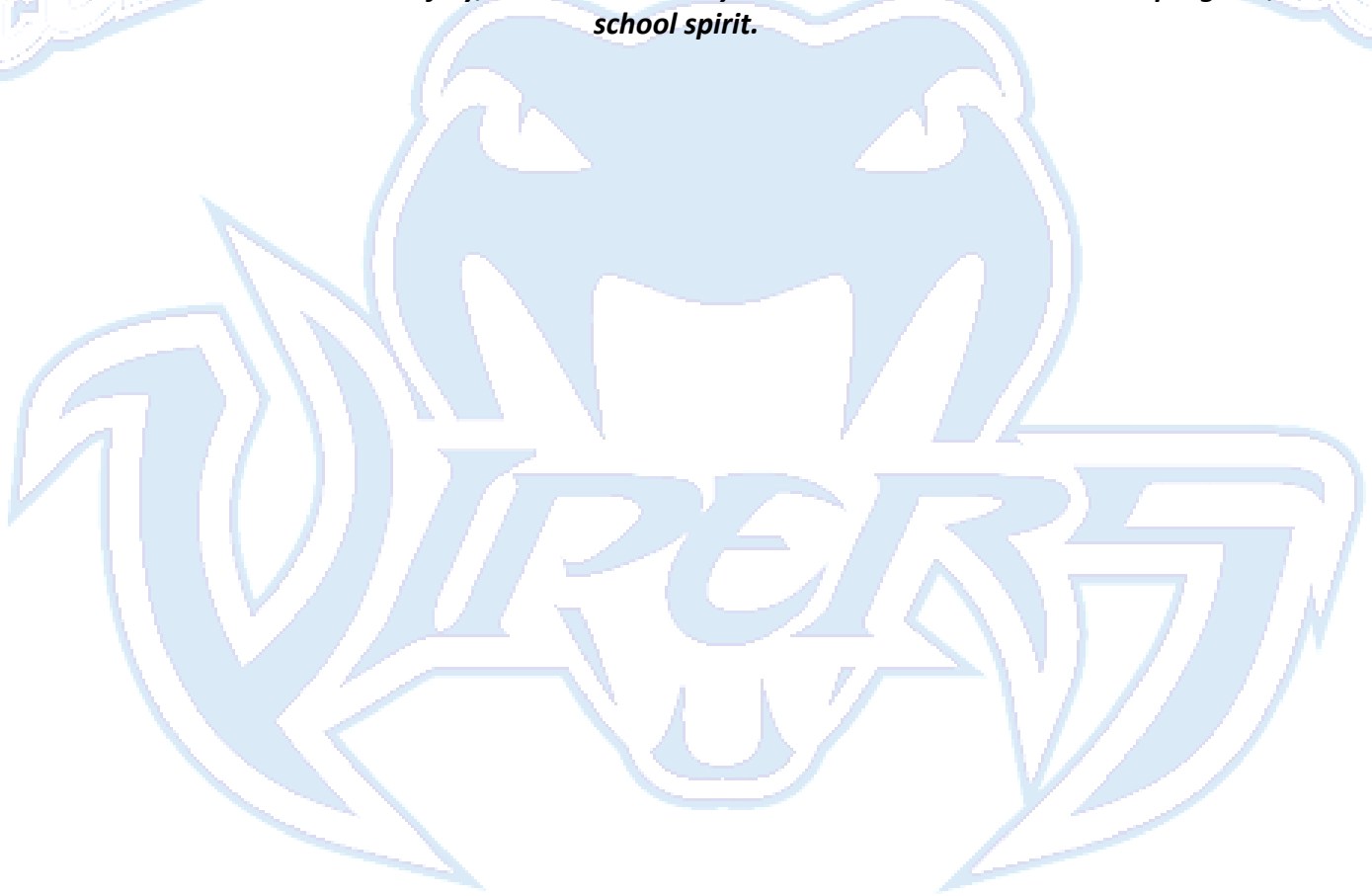
### Board Policy 5132: Dress and Grooming
